Our weekly event schedule in October, is as follows, unless modified by a club or outside event. Please note that many afternoon times have changed, as there isn't nearly as much daylight left as in the spring and summer months.

Sundays – Mixed Pack at 1:15

## **EVENTS IN OCTOBER**

Things slow down a little bit after October, but next month is still full of activities.

**INTRACLUB RYDER CUP SUNDAY OCTOBER 2** - This is open to all members regardless of handicap. The format is two person match play, with six holes of alternate shot, six best ball, and six captain's choice. Ryan and I will pick our teams, and we will ourselves play an afternoon match ( We're playing captains, not just coaching captains.) The entry fee of \$11 plus cart ( \$25 total ) includes lunch for everyone and a gift certificate for the winning team. There will be an 8:30 shotgun and a 1:45 shotgun start, although the morning group won't know the final results until everyone is in Sunday evening. Entry deadline is noon on Saturday, October 1, so Ryan and I can pick the teams and have everything ready for Sunday morning.
